## General waste collection



No waste is collected on official public holidays.

**What?** Milk cartons, juice cartons, soup cartons, frozen food packaging, aluminium biscuit containers, wet-strength paper, plastic-coated paper, plastic, flower wrapping paper, labels/other self-adhesive stickers, detergent drums, dirty paper, dirty cartons, any waste, plastic and paper bags, etc.

**How?** Only in tied, **official refuse bags**. Anything else will be left behind. Commercial enterprises and businesses use waste containers marked with their logo. It may be open up to max. 15 cm. **Violations subject to Fr. 200.– fine.**

**Where?** At the usual refuse collection point by the road.

**When?** Every Monday and Thursday morning, from 7 am. Waste must be placed ready on the collection day by no later than 7 am, but **no earlier than on the previous evening from 5 pm.** **Violations subject to Fr. 100.– fine.**

## Seals / bags

**Official refuse bags, seals, compost bags, fees for cardboard disposal (official string, seals, labels)** are available at Coop Visp/Eyholz and Migros.

## Agglo-Ökohof in Gamsen

The Commune of Visp cooperates with Agglo-Ökohof in Gamsen. This means:

- No annual usage fee is charged (this is assumed by the commune).
- A one-time deposit of Fr. 20.– is paid for the Ökohof ticket.
- Comprehensive solutions for disposal and recycling.

The Ökohof ticket can be ordered online or collected directly at the office. Only one ticket per household is permitted.

## Household appliances / TV



**What?** Office, telecommunications and computer equipment

- Consumer electronics
- Small and large household appliances
- Electronic devices
- Lamps and lights

**How?** Free – recycling fee paid in advance

**When?** At the beginning of september (for dates, see "vaz"), at Platz Sepp Blatter- Schulhaus or free of charge at sales outlets, dealers or manufacturers.

## Used clothes



**How?** Disposal in the four permanent used clothes containers

**Where?** • at Hubel

- at Baretstrasse
- at Müra car park
- at Coop in Eyholz

## Construction materials



**What?** Tiles, stones, scrap wood, etc.

**How?** In exchange for a normal market fee collected by the operator.

**Where?** Regional landfill for inert materials "Moos" in Ried-Brig or Ökohof in Gamsen (see above for opening times).

**When?** Opening times: 8 am – 12 pm noon and 1 pm – 4:30 pm. Landfill operator: Theler Moos Ried-Brig AG, Tel. 027 934 30 56 / [deponie@thelerag.ch](mailto:deponie@thelerag.ch).

## Paper



**What?** Newspapers, inserts, magazines, brochures, prospectuses, letters, recycled paper, computer lists, note paper, telephone directories, unbound books, catalogues, photocopies.

**IMPORTANT: no plastic sleeves / bindings etc.**

**What's not?** Carrier bags made from plastic / paper (due to special material not suitable for paper processing), sacks, milk and Tetra cartons, filling material, plastics such as Sagex, etc.: all of these materials must be disposed of in general waste.

**How?** Bundles tied with string. **No carrier bags, sacks and boxes may be used** because these are made from non-recyclable materials.

**Where?** At the usual refuse collection point by the road.

**When?** **Visp:** Saturday morning, from 7am: 20 January, 16 March, 27 April, 15 June, 24 August, 12 October, 30 November. **Eyholz:** Saturday morning, from 7:30 am: 23 March, 22 June, 24 August, 23 November.

## Cardboard



**What?** **Cardboard only! No paper!** Corrugated cardboard (without plastic adhesive strips), egg cartons, fruit and vegetable cartons (without plastic adhesive strips and boxes).

**What's not?** **No paper!** Milk and Tetra cartons, filling materials, plastics such as Sagex, etc. must all be disposed of in the general waste.

**How?** Cut open, press flat and **tie with the official, special cardboard string for the Commune of Visp** (available at Coop Visp / Eyholz, Migros) in a crosswise manner. **Violations subject to Fr. 100.– fine**

**Where?** At the usual refuse collection point by the road.

**When?** **NEW: Every Wednesday, from 9 am.**

On **April** and **Martini market** days, no cardboard waste is collected in the area of the market stands. Businesses and residents in the centre are asked to place their cardboard outside this area for collection. For other districts, cardboard waste is collected as normal.

## Aluminium



**What?** a) Aluminium drinks cans.  
b) Other aluminium waste and sheet steel.

**Where?**

a) Dispose of in the containers provided at the sales outlets.  
b) Dispose of in the containers provided at Baretstrasse, at Mattaweg, at PP cemetery, at PP Müra, at the camping site / swimming pool and in Eyholz near Restaurant Sport.

**How?** Rinse out and crush empty cans. Remove labels and stickers.

## Waste glass



**Free – recycling fee paid in advance**

**What?** All types of waste glass.

**How?** Separated into green glass, white glass and brown glass. **Glass only! Take containers (carrier bags etc.) back with you and dispose of correctly.**

**Where?** Dispose of in the glass containers provided at Baretstrasse, at Mattaweg, at PP cemetery, at PP Müra, at the camping site / swimming pool and in Eyholz near Restaurant Sport.

## Waste oil



**What?** All types of waste oil.

**How?** Pour carefully into waste tank and take the container (carrier bag etc.) back with you and dispose of correctly.

**Where?** In the waste oil containers provided at Baretstrasse, at Mattaweg, at PP cemetery, at PP Müra, at the camping site / swimming pool and in Eyholz near Restaurant Sport.

**When?** Due to the noise disturbance, the disposal of aluminium, waste glass and waste oil is only allowed on weekdays between 8 am and 8 pm.

**Please consider the residents and respect the disposal times. Violations subject to Fr. 100.– fine.**

## Bulky items



**What?** Combustible bulky items such as sofas, upholstered chairs, etc.

**How?** Attach an **official bulky items label** (available in the same stores as the official refuse bags).

- Bulky item up to max. 2 m in length and max. 10 kg: **Bulky items label for Fr. 5.–**
- Bulky item up to max. 2 m in length and max. 30 kg: **Bulky items label for Fr. 12.50**

**Where?** At the usual refuse collection point by the road.

**When?** With the normal refuse collection on Monday and Thursday, from 7 am.

## Kitchen / catering waste



**What?** Kitchen and catering waste.

**How?** Only in official 60l containers, which can be ordered from ERTAG (tel. 027 924 14 11). Official seals for Fr. 10.– per container are available from the commune. **Free of charge for private individuals.**

**Where?** At the usual refuse collection point by the road.

**When?** Weekly on **Tuesday morning, from 7:30 am.**

## Green waste



**What?** Wood cuttings, shrubbery, Christmas trees, branches, leaves, lawn cuttings and garden waste. **No kitchen and catering waste (see above).**

**How?** Open and handy vessels, buckets, boxes or crates or neatly tied bundles. The buckets must be widest at the top (they may not become narrower at the top). Private individuals: free of charge. Companies and organisations can contact ERTAG (tel. 027 924 14 11) directly.

**Where?** At the usual refuse collection point by the road, **no private delivery** to the biogas plant Max Stalder possible.

**When?** March – November: every Friday, from 7:30 am. December – February (due to lower amount of green waste): every 14 days on Friday, from 7:30 am (for dates, see "vaz").

## Hazardous waste



**What?** Chemicals, emulsions, descaling agents, paints, poisons, wood protection agents, bleach, alkalis, solvents, medication, plant protection agents, cleaning agents with a hazard symbol, acids, spray cans, mercury thermometers → List of hazardous waste: [www.abfall-oberwallis.ch](http://www.abfall-oberwallis.ch).

• Clearly label hazardous waste as "hazardous waste" and store properly at home until the collection date.

**How?** Toxic substances should be brought in sealed containers, if possible in the original container with the label.

**When?** At the beginning of september (for dates, see "vaz")

**Where?** At Platz des Sepp Blatter-Schulhauses.

## Batteries



**What?** All types of batteries.

**When?** **At the sales outlets.** Dealers and manufacturers of batteries are obliged to accept old batteries free of charge due to the fee paid in advance at the time of purchase (batteries up to 5 kg).

## Iron scrap / metals



**Where?** At the scrap iron compound of "Gebrüder Bumann" in Wehreye.

**How?** Non-metallic substances such as plastic, rubber, leather, wood, etc. must be removed from the metal in advance. Otherwise, the normal market fee must be charged.

**When?** During the opening hours of the scrap iron compound. Information: Tel. 027 952 28 20.

## Animal carcasses



**What?** Animal carcasses and slaughterhouse waste in buckets or sacks.

**How?** At the regional animal carcass collection point, tel. 027 948 59 30, in the north west of Visp wastewater treatment plant, beneath the former "Schwarzer Graben" shooting range.
