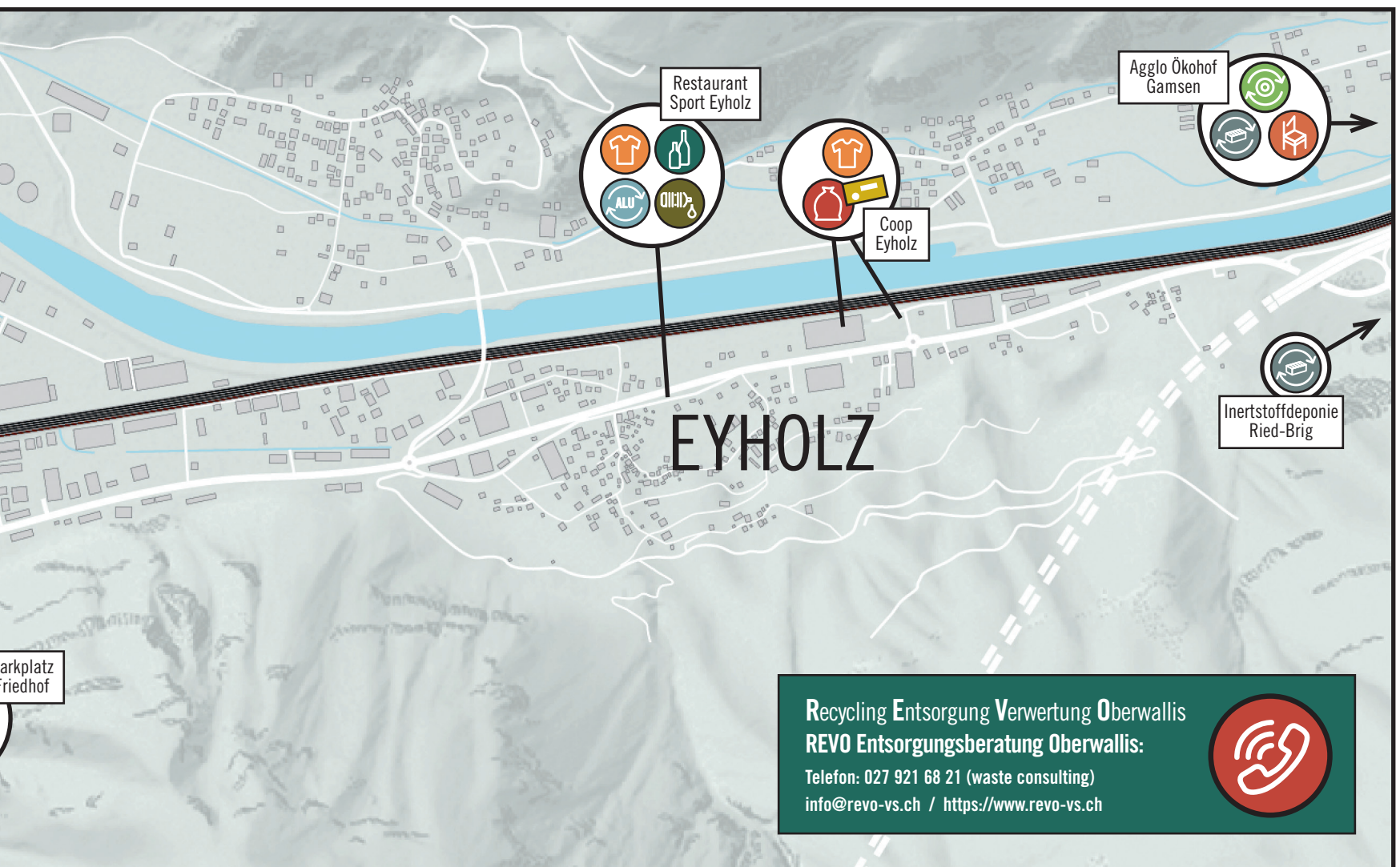

General waste collection



- What?** Milk cartons, juice cartons, soup cartons, frozen food packaging, aluminium biscuit containers, wet-strength paper, plastic-coated paper, plastic, flower wrapping paper, labels/ other self-adhesive stickers, detergent drums, dirty paper, dirty cartons, any waste, plastic and paper bags etc.
- How?** Only in tied, **official refuse bags**. Anything else will be left behind. Commercial enterprises and businesses use waste containers marked with their logo. It may be open up to max. 15 cm. **Violations subject to Fr. 200.— fine.**
- Where?** At the usual refuse collection point on the street.
- When?** **Every Monday and Thursday morning, from 7 am.** Waste must be placed ready on the collection day by no later than 7 am, but **no earlier than on the previous evening from 5 pm.** **Violations subject to Fr. 100.— fine.**

No waste is collected on official public holidays.

Seals / bags



Official refuse bags, seals, compost bags and bulky good labels are available at Coop Visp+Eyholz and Migros.

Agglo-Ökohof Gamsen



The Commune of Visp cooperates with Agglo-Ökohof (Ecological-Centre) in Gamsen. This means:

- A one-time deposit of Fr. 20.— is paid for the Ökohof ticket.
- Comprehensive solutions for disposal and recycling.

The Ökohof ticket can be ordered online or collected directly at the Agglo-Ökohof office. Only one ticket per household is permitted.

Opening times of Agglo-Ökohof in Gamsen :

Monday to Friday : 1 pm–5 pm, Saturday : 8 am–12.30 pm noon
(Office opening hours: Monday to Friday: 7 am–12 pm / 1 pm–5 pm)

Aluminium



- Cans:** Throw aluminium beverage cans in the containers provided at the sales outlets.
- Rest:** Throw remaining aluminium and sheet steel in the containers at Bätetstrasse, Mattaweg, cemetery parking lot, Mura parking, the camping site / swimming pool and in Eyholz near Restaurant Sport.
- How?** Rinse out and crush empty cans. Remove labels and sticker.

Waste glass



- What?** All types of waste glass.
- How?** **Free of charge — recycling fee paid in advance.** Separated into green, white and brown glass. **Glass only ! Take containers (carrier bags etc.) back with you and dispose of them properly.**
- Where?** In the glass containers provided at Bätetstrasse, Mattaweg, cemetery parking lot, Mura parking, the camping site / swimming pool and in Eyholz near Restaurant Sport.
- When?** Due to disturbance of the peace at night, the disposal of aluminium and waste glass is only permitted on working days between 8 am and 8 pm. **Out of consideration for neighbouring residents, please adhere to the disposal times (not between 8 pm and 8 am). Offenders will be fined Fr. 100.—.**

Waste oil



- What?** All used oil **in small quantities from private households.**
- How?** Pour carefully into waste tank and **take the containers (carrier bags etc.) back with you and dispose of properly.**
- Where?** In the waste oil containers provided at Bätetstrasse, Mattaweg, cemetery parking lot, Mura parking, the camping site / swimming pool and in Eyholz near Restaurant Sport.

Household appliances



- What?** • Office, telecommunications and computer equipment
• Consumer electronics, Television sets
• Small and large household appliances
• Electronic devices • Lamps and lights
- How?** **Free — recycling fee paid in advance**
- Where?** Free of charge at sales outlets, dealers or manufacturers. On Tuesday, 9 September 2025 from 2.50 pm to 4 pm on the square of the Sepp Blatter schoolhouse.

Used clothes



- How?** Disposal in the white used clothes containers
- Where?** at Hubel, camping site / swimming pool, Mattaweg, Bätetstrasse, parking Mura, Rest. Sport Eyholz, Coop Eyholz.

Construction materials



- What?** Tiles, stones, scrap wood etc.
- How?** In exchange for a normal market fee collected by the operator.
- Where?** Regional landfill for inert materials "Moos" in Ried-Brig or Ökohof in Gamsen (see left for opening times). Landfill "Moos" Tel. 027 934 30 56 / deponie@thelerag.ch, Mo.–Fr. from 8 am to 12 noon and 1 pm to 4 pm. (Winter holidays until January 13, 2025).

Batteries



- Where?** **At the points of sale.** Retailers and manufacturers of batteries are obliged to take back batteries up to 5 kg free of charge due to the advance fee already paid at the time of purchase.

Bulky items



- What?** Flammable bulky items such as sofas, chairs etc.
- How?** Attach an **official bulky items label (available in the same stores as the official refuse bags)**
a) Bulky item up to max. 2 m in length and max. 10 kg: **Bulky items label for Fr. 5.—**
b) Bulky item up to max. 2 m in length and max. 30 kg: **Bulky items label for Fr. 12.50**
- Where?** At the usual refuse collection point on the street.
- When?** With the general waste collection on Monday and Thursday, from 7 am.

Kitchen/catering waste



- How?** **Only in official 60 l barrels**, which can be ordered from ERTAG (Tel. 027 924 14 11). Official seals for Fr. 10.— per container are available from the municipality. **Free of charge for private individuals.**
- Where?** At the usual refuse collection point on the street.
- When?** Weekly on **Tuesday mornings from 7.30 am.**

Green waste collection



- What?** Wood cuttings, shrubs, Christmas trees, branches, leaves, grass cuttings and garden waste. **No kitchen and catering waste (see above).**
- How?** Open and handy vessels, buckets, boxes or crates or neatly tied bundles. The buckets must be widest at the top (they may narrow towards the bottom). Private individuals: free of charge. Companies can contact ERTAG (Tel. 027 924 14 11) directly.
- Where?** At the usual refuse collection point on the street.
- When?** **March–November:** every Friday, from 7.30 am.
December–February (due to lower amount of green waste): every two weeks on Friday, from 7.30 am (for dates, see "vaz").

Paper



- What?** Newspapers, inserts, magazines, brochures, prospectuses, letters, recycled paper, computer lists, note paper, telephone directories, unbound books, catalogues, photocopies. **IMPORTANT: no plastic sleeves / bindings etc.**
- What's not?** Carrier bags made from plastic / paper (due to special material not suitable for paper processing), sacks, milk and Tetra cartons, filling material, plastics such as Sagex etc.: all of these materials must be disposed of in general waste.
- How?** Bundles tied with string. No carrier bags, sacks and boxes may be used because these are made from non-recyclable materials.
- Where?** At the usual refuse collection point on the street.
- When?** **Visp:** Saturday mornings, from 7 am: January 18, March 15, May 3, June 14, August 23, October 11, November 29
Eyholz: Saturday mornings, from 7.30 am: March 22, June 21, August 23, November 22

Cardboard



- What?** **Cardboard only, no paper !** Corrugated cardboard boxes (without plastic adhesive strips), egg cartons, fruit and vegetable cartons (without plastic adhesive strips) and cardboard boxes, shredded paper.
- What's not?** No paper! Milk and tetra cartons, filling materials, plastics such as Sagex etc.: all of these materials must be disposed of in general waste.
- How?** Cardboard cut open, press flat and tie crosswise with string. For businesses, the disposal of shredded paper continues as before. **Violations subject to Fr. 100.— fine.**
- Where?** To the usual garbage disposal area on the street.
- When?** **Every Wednesday, from 9 am** except on official public holidays. (On the days of the April, September and Martini markets, there is no cardboard collection in the market stall area. Shops or residents of the center are asked to leave their cardboard outside the market area for collection. For the other districts, cardboard collection is carried out as usual.)

Hazardous waste



- What?** Chemicals from private households, emulsions, decalcifiers, paints, poisons, wood preservatives, bleach, alkalis, solvents, medication, pesticides, cleaning agents with a hazard symbols, acids, spray cans, mercury thermometers
- Intoxi-cation** **Emergency** **Tel. 145** **—> List of hazardous waste : <https://www.revo-vs.ch/>**
• Clearly mark hazardous waste as **"hazardous waste"** and store properly at home until the collection date.
- What not?** Company-specific hazardous waste. Large quantities/industrial packaging. Camping gas bottles and gas cylinders with butane and propane. Fire extinguishers.
- How?** Only for private individuals. Toxic substances should be brought in sealed containers, if possible in the original container with a label. Take back up to 20 kg per household free of charge. Only in sealed containers. No mixtures. Containers may weigh no more than 15 kg or 10 litres per container.
- When?** On **Tuesday, September 9, 2025 from 2.50 pm to 4 pm.**
- Where?** On the square of the Sepp Blatter schoolhouse.

Scrap iron / metals



- Where?** At the scrap iron loading area of "Gebrüder Bumann" in Pomona.
- How?** Non-metallic substances such as plastic, rubber, leather, wood etc. must be removed from the metal in advance. Otherwise, the normal market fee must be charged.
- When?** During the opening hours of the scrap iron compound. Information: Tel. 027 952 28 20.

Animal carcasses



- What?** Animal carcasses and slaughterhouse waste in buckets or sacks.
- Where?** At the regional animal carcass collection point, in the north west of Visp wastewater treatment plant. Tel. 027 948 63 30.
- When?** Mo.–Fr.: 9–11 am and 2–4 pm. In an emergency outside opening hours: Tel. 079 734 39 85.
